4412 NOTE: Loosely secure the footpeg to the appropriate adapter.

STEP 2 Install the left and right Flamin' Switchblade Pegs in the footpeg mounts on the motorcycle. Leave the footpeg adapter fastener loose for now.

NOTE: The footpeg mount will positively engage the peg when tightened; determine the desired position before fully tightening.

STEP 3 Adjust the angle of the footpeg on the male mount then secure with the footpeg fastener.

STEP 4 Check the angle for comfort; re-adjust if necessary. Repeat for the opposite side.

NOTE: Ensure that all of the fasteners are tight before operating the motorcycle. See PIC.1, PIC.2, and PIC.3.

ADJUST DETENT SPRING TENSION

If the swing arm feels loose, adjust the detent spring tension using the set screw on the underside of the swing arm. See PIC. 3.

REPLACE THE CURB FEELERS

When the curb feelers become worn, replace them with Kuryakyn P/N 404475CF. Be sure to use red Loctite on the threads to secure the fitting.

REPLACE THE RUBBER PADS

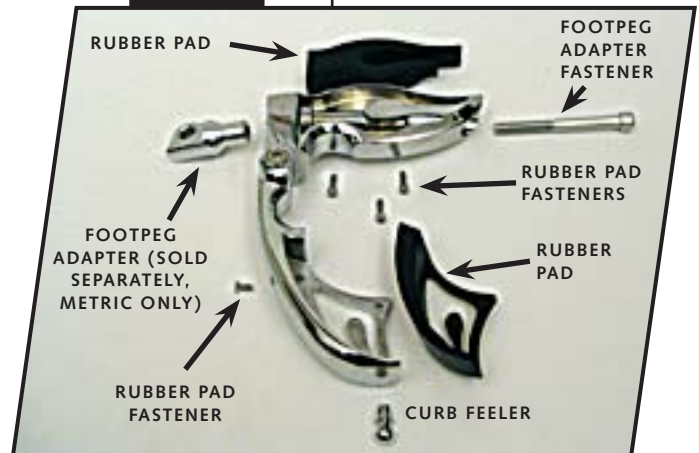
When the rubber pads become worn, replace them with Kuryakyn P/N 424411, 434411, 424414 and 434414. Remove the footpegs from the motorcycle, then remove the fasteners securing the rubber pads, see PIC. 2 and PIC. 3. Install the new pads and secure with the fasteners. The rubber pads on the swing arms are glued in place.
